Cuba CON-PARA

I International Congress of Comparative and Constitutional Law

Professors, researchers, students, and other professionals of Law and Political Science from all over the world are invited to the I International Congress of Comparative and Constitutional Law "Cuba CON-PARA", to be held in Havana, from April 4 to 6, 2023.

Cuba CON-PARA has been conceived as a unique space for knowledge interchange from a comparative perspective and on the most current concerns of Constitutional Law.

The Congress has been structured into eight thematic axis that cover the most important areas of constitutional interest.

- **Axis n. 1:** Comparative Law: epistemology, analysis, implementation, and challenges.
- **Axis n. 2:** Constitutionalism in critical perspective from the global South: identities, race, gender, intersectional approach.
- **Axis n. 3:** Beyond the Nature-Culture dualism: the protection of the environment, ecosystems, and Mother Earth.
- **Axis n. 4:** Latin America at the polls: impacts on forms of government.
- **Axis n. 5:** Constitutional reforms, beyond procedure and constitutional rigidity.
- **Axis n. 6:** Citizenship in a debate: plurality, interculturality, human mobility.
- **Axis n. 7:** Instruments to guarantee rights in comparative perspective.
- **Axis n. 8:** The "engine room" of the constitution.

In addition to the central conferences, which are previously requested by the organizing committee, participants may intervene through:

- Presentation (15 minutes)
- Communication (7 minutes)
- Poster (7 minutes)

To confirm your in-person participation as a speaker, communicator, or poster author, you must send the corresponding extended abstract, meeting the requirements found on the congress website <https://www.cubaconpara.com> and in the attached form.

Virtual presentations, communications, and posters had not been planned. The congress sessions can be followed via streaming (more information on the web).

Languages in which contributions may be submitted:   

The admission period for contributions expires on February 15, 2023. Through the secretariat, a response will be given on the acceptance or rejection within ten days after sending the extended abstract.

A quota of 115 interventions has been planned for the two and a half days of work.

 - 4.2 Times New Roman font typology, at 12 points.
 - 4.3 Interlined to 1.5.
 - 4.4 Submit in PDF format.

Communication (7 minutes)

1. Title.
2. Thematic axis in which the paper is inserted.
3. Keywords, separated by commas (between 3 and 5).
4. An extended summary of the paper (3 pages) that includes the objectives, essential ideas, and conclusions.

- 4.1 Letter page size (8.15 X 11 inches) and Normal (standardized) margins to 1 inch on all four sides of the page).
- 4.2 Times New Roman font typology, at 12 points.
- 4.3 Interlined to 1.5.
- 4.4 Submit in PDF format.

Poster (7 minutes)

1. Title.
2. Thematic axis in which the paper is inserted.
3. Keywords, separated by commas (between 3 and 5).
4. Summary of the poster (1 page) describing the expository dynamic and related concepts.
 - 4.1 Letter page size (8.15 X 11 inches) and Normal (standardized) margins to 1 inch on all four sides of the page).
 - 4.2 Times New Roman font typology, at 12 points.
 - 4.3 Interlined to 1.5.
 - 4.4 Submit in PDF format.
